
International Women's Day Celebration"

Pabiben learned the famed embroidery of her community, but before she could complete making her own dowry, the elder council of the community banned its use completely because they believed women spent too much time on the embroidery, leading to late marriages. Meanwhile, the

Dhebaria women who worked with Pabiben, searched for a way to solve their design problem: how could they continue with their craft without breaking the community rules... The authenticity of her bags blends completely with modern aesthetics. Moreover, her craft is not just a result of hard-work and creativity but it also echoes the voice of women empowerment. Pabbiben's speech is very motivational and empowering to all participants.

No wonder, a lady like Pabiben Rabari is an inspiration for all women who should shape their own future, and those of their families and future generations. She is an idol to many in her community. At present, there are around 50 women from her village working with her but she aims to help more women to create their identity with the help of their artistic talent, she has narrated her story of being an entrepreneur despite her lack of education and society restriction.
